



Business Curbside Recycling

Curbside recycling collection may be available for businesses located on existing residential routes. If your business would like to start recycling, please contact the City to confirm eligibility.

Limited to **5 Blue Boxes** and **2 tied bundles of cardboard** per collection.



Paper	Containers
Household paper	Glass bottles & jars Please remove food and rinse
Newspapers & flyers	Cartons e.g. milk, juice, soup
Egg cartons, tubes & boxes Flatten and remove plastics	Cardboard cans e.g. frozen juice cans
Magazines, catalogues & books Remove hard covers	Ice cream tubs
Cardboard boxes Flatten and tie in bundles up to 75 cm x 75 cm x 20 cm Drop off oversized or large quantities at an EnviroDepot	Plastic containers e.g. cups, bottles, jugs, tubs, pots, trays and clamshells
	Rigid plastic e.g. packaging around toys, batteries, etc.
	Steel cans Please rinse. Place lids inside.
	Empty metal paint cans Remove lids
	Empty aerosol cans
	Aluminum foil & containers

Recycling DON'Ts

Paper: Unbagged shredded paper, waxed or foiled paper & boxes, construction paper, gift wrap, photos or wood

Glass: Broken glass, dishes, drinking glasses, ceramics, light bulbs, mirrors, window panes

Plastic: All wraps, films, packaging, bags, pouches, cutlery, Styrofoam™, foam packaging, hangers, toys, dishes, coffee pods

Metal: Hangers, pots & pans, propane canisters, appliances, batteries

Other: Hazardous and Special Product containers, all medical waste, wooden food crates

Recycling DOs

- Empty or rinse all containers
- Maximum weight is 18 kg (40 lbs)
- Sort it Right!
- Use 2 or more Blue Boxes
- Use Blue Boxes between 45-95 L

Hazardous and Special Products (HSP)

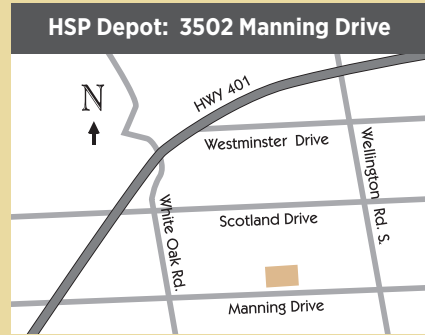

HSP is any waste that might be flammable, corrosive, toxic, or explosive and does not belong in regular garbage.

Businesses may dispose of small quantities of HSP at the Depot for no charge but must complete a Small Quantity Exemption form.

 - pesticides & fertilizers

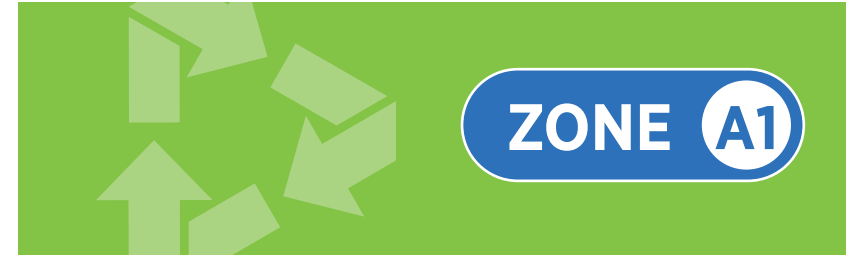

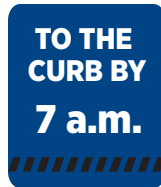

ZONE A1

Business Curbside Collection

Eligible business can receive weekly garbage collection.

All garbage must be bagged for collection.

- Maximum weight for a bag is 20 kg (44 lbs).
- Maximum size is 125 L.
- Maximum 12 bags per collection.
- Loose items or open bags will not be collected.
- Garbage in cans will not be collected.
- All mirrors, glass, or sharp items must be sealed separately in cardboard and labeled 'caution sharps' for collection.



Place garbage or recycling to curb by 7 a.m. on collection day, but not before 6 p.m. the night before.

Scavengers and animals may rip open bags left out overnight, making them uncollectable. Setting out bags in the morning before 7a.m. can prevent scavenging.

Please keep collectors safe by placing waste on level ground, within 1 m of the curb and not on snowbanks.

Trade waste such as wooden pallets, discarded inventory, equipment and machine parts are not collectable at the curb.

Businesses do not receive bulk item or furniture collection. Large items can be taken to the landfill for disposal; metal items and appliances can be recycled at no charge at the landfill (3502 Manning Drive).

The Green Bin program is not provided to businesses.
